#### **Rehearsals**

- Before Christmas
  - Weekly Thursday rehearsals from 19<sup>th</sup> September 7.30pm-10pm, last rehearsal 12th December (no rehearsal on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October)
  - o Weekly Wednesday rehearsal where needed
- After Christmas
  - Two rehearsals a week; Thursday 7.30pm-10pm and Sunday 2pm-5pm from Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January, (6pm in February)
  - o Wednesday eve 7.30pm-9.30pm Choreography & Principal development.
- Make Up & Promotional Photographs Day Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> January (11am-4pm)
- Panto week
  - o Thursday 13th February first dress rehearsal
  - o Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February first technical rehearsal
  - Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> February technical and full run through. This is our final opportunity to rehearse the show and is a long tiring day.
  - o Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February charity performance
  - Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> February performance
  - o Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> February performance
  - o Friday 21st February gala performance
  - Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February two performances
  - Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> February clean-up day

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#### **Hall Housekeeping**

Everyone involved in the show, both on and off stage, is expected to help maintain the hall both during rehearsals and performance week be prepared to ensure that these tasks are shared evenly amongst the group and you will be expected to take your turn.

#### **Publicity**

Video recordings and photographs will be taken of both children and adult company members during rehearsals and performances. These will be used for publicity purposes including social media. Names will not be published.

#### Costumes

- All cast members must provide their own footwear, accessories and trim.
- All cast members, and parents of children provided with costumes, must take care of them and keep them clean and ironed.
- During dress rehearsals and panto week you will be in your separate changing areas, we ask that you maintain modesty by always wearing hotpants/shorts and bras/vests/slips under your costumes to prevent any compromising situations.
- During performances there may be some quick changes that may require help, if you
  would prefer to have a named buddy to assist you, please nominate a person and let
  them and our Safeguarding Officers Jo Morcom & Jo Swan know to avoid any
  confusion.
- Please leave costumes hung on the clothes rails and a member of the costume committee will put away at the end of the pantomime.

#### **Insurance**

- The Clockhouse Players insurance only covers equipment owned or hired by us.
- If you bring valuable personal possessions to rehearsals or performances, it will be at your own risk.

#### **Behaviour**

- It is important for everyone to recognise that we have a large number of young members and that their welfare is always top priority.
- No taking cigarette/vape breaks, only at official break time are you able to do so.
- Under 16yrs old members must be collected by an adult, if they wish to walk home, we would require written consent from their parent.
- All members are expected to act appropriately at all times during rehearsals and performances.
- All adult members are expected to provide a positive role model for dealing with other people.
- Mobile phones are to be put away during rehearsals.
